



## Course Title: Low Budget Filmmaking [Basics]

### Overview:

For many aspiring filmmakers producing a film is seen as a vastly complex and vastly expensive process. This course, however, will equip learners (who have not had any, or indeed limited, training) with the skills and knowledge to write, direct and edit their own independent films utilizing everyday resources to your vision into a reality.

### Course outline:

Students will be guided on the application of the basic principles of filmmaking with emphasis on:

- Turning an idea into a screenplay.
- Being an effective and creative producer
- Directing your vision into reality
- Effective, stylish but ultimately affordable art-direction
- Editing your film

### Who should attend:

Learners with an interest in filmmaking who have the intention of learning the skills of screenwriting, producing, directing and editing for low-budget films.

### Level: Beginner

The course will be developed to fit beginners as well as learners with limited exposure to filmmaking.

### Admission requirements:

- Level 1 is open to all.
- Participants must hold a certificate in level 1 before moving onto level 2.
