

## ADDITIONAL MEDIA EXPENSES: 2010

---

Students must budget for additional consumable media expenses that occur during the course of the year and vary according to their assignments. About R2 000 per module will be sufficient. At the beginning of each module lecturers will supply students with detailed lists of required media for that module's assignments.

The following equipment is required:

### COMPUTERS

It is highly desirable that foundation students should have access to a computer (Apple Mac or PC) at home. Senior students **must have** workstations at home.

The minimum requirements are:

#### Hardware

- *PC (Windows XP – service pack 3 or Vista Service pack 1) platform*

CPU	Duo Core Pentium IV 3.2GHz or higher
Memory	2 Gig minimum
Display Card	Nvidia screen card 256MB or newer (NO ATI cards)
HDD	500G, Serial ATA 100 meg/s
Monitor	17 Inch
- *Mac (OS 10.5 - Leopard) platform (iMac, or Macbook minimum)*

CPU	2.4GHz Intel Core 2 Duo processor or higher
Memory	2 Gig minimum
Display Card	Nvidia screen card 256MB or newer (NO ATI cards)
HDD	500G, Serial ATA 100 meg/s

#### Extras

- DVDR, Keyboard, mouse.
  - Screencard: 1,280x800 minimum display. At least 256 memory, 16-bit screen screen card (don't buy ATI screen cards as conflicts with animation software occur).
  - A DVD-writer.
  - A Mac compatible memory stick (indicated on packaging, or ask shop assistant) preferably at least 4Gb.
  - A scanner.
  - Internet connection.
