- Only learners who are currently in **Grade 12** or who were in Grade 12 in 2019 and are taking a gap year are allowed to enter this competition. This competition is *not open to current registered students* at The Open Window.
- **02** Only learners that have completed the **Application process for 2021 enrollment** will be considered
- **03** The Bursary will be awarded for students registering for **Degree studies** at the Open Window.
- Admission to OW programmes will be based on our standard admission requirements per programme. The bursary will only be viable for candidates that meet Degree entry requirements.
- **05** To ensure students are able to complete their academic journey with us, a Student Advisor will complete a financial consultation with prospective students before registration.
- **06** Entries must be submitted on time, by **15 December 2020, BEFORE 21:00**. Artworks submitted after this deadline will not be considered.
- **07** All artworks submitted must be the entrant's **own original work**.
- **08** Plagiarised, illegible, incomplete, defaced or corrupt entries will not be considered.
- **09** In order to be considered for a bursary, all **5 frames** in the visual narrative must be entered.
- **10** Once a submission is received, you will not be able to modify it whatsoever.
- **11** The Open Window has the right to report any artworks that condone hate speech and propaganda of violence against race, creed, gender or sexual orientation.
- 12 Your artworks might be published on The Open Window's website or social media platforms, as well as included on certain virtual exhibitions.
- **13** No royalties will be paid in the framework of this competition.
- **14** The Open Window's decision on all matters pertaining to the competition is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 15 It is at the sole discretion of The Open Window to award study bursary prizes.
- 16 The bursary shortlist will be published on The Open Window's website on the 14th of January 2021.
- 17 Shortlisted entrants for bursary prizes must be available for Skype/Google Meet/Zoom interviews between the 15th of January 2021.
- 18 The bursary winners will be announced on The Open Window's website on 18 January 2021.
- **19** Bursaries may **NOT** be exchanged for cash, are not transferable and are only **valid for the year 2021**.
- **20** Entries received after the 15th of December 2020 will NOT be accepted towards the competition.
